




Message from the Principal

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Post Graduate Government College-46 established in 1982 and affiliated with Panjab University, is a prominent multidisciplinary institution in southern Chandigarh. Initially a boys' college offering B.A. and B.Com, it has since expanded to include programs such as BBA, BCA, M.Com, and Environment Conservation. In May 2024, the college received a Grade 'B+' with a CGPA of 2.72 in its Cycle-III NAAC accreditation. It has Education adopted the National Policy(NEP) 2020, emphasizing multidisciplinary learning and development, from the 2024 session onwards.

The institution has well-equipped classrooms with innovative technology and full LAN connectivity. Compact design and skilled teachers ensure interactive learning. Thirteen labs support practical skills, while sports facilities and accessible infrastructure promote overall development.









Additionally, the IT Block with computer labs, lecture theatres, a soundproof audio room, a skill lab, and classrooms with a lift facility enhance the teaching-learning process to suit modern times. The ongoing construction of separate hostels for boys and girls is expected to be operational by the 2025–26 academic session. The college library has a collection of 48953 books, including textbooks, general books, reference books, and a book bank; access to e-resources, e-journals, and e-books under the N-LIST programme; 24 journals; 33 magazines and 12 newspapers. The college remains committed to inclusive, value-based education and academic excellence.








LIBRARY


The college library has,



FEE CONCESSION & SCHOLARSHIPS

Various scholarships under different schemes of the Government of India, Chandigarh Administration, State Government of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, and some private bodies/NGOs were made available to the students of the college. During the session 2024-25, application forms of 126 students of the college were verified for scholarships after their registration on the National Scholarship Portal, a dedicated online scholarship portal for various scholarship schemes offered by the Government of India, and 2 forms of students are verified on Dr. B R Ambedkar Scholarship Portal, scholarship offered by Panjab Government. In addition to this, 25 students are shortlisted for the Student Aid Fund and 5 students are provisionally selected for Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi. Furthermore, Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) was sanctioned to our college for the distribution of free books and stationery items to SC/ST students. Poor and needy students were also rendered help through funds collected from college staff.


